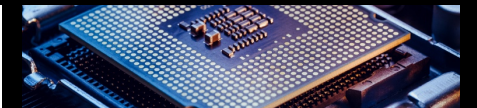
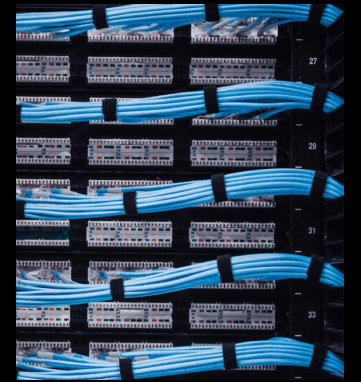
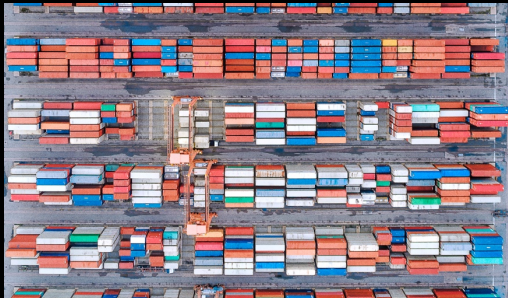

How do You Install InterSystems Today?

- 1. Open Download page
- 2. Download package.zip
- 3. Unzip the archive into Folder
- 4. Open Management Portal...
- ...
- ...
- ...
- 12 Install the package

Zpm:USER> install package

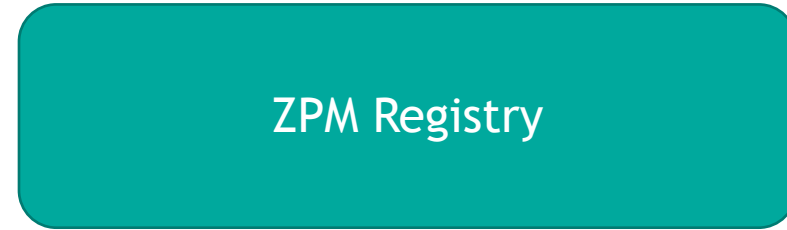
Installed!

Package Manager: How It Works?

zpm-client lets you install packages from zpm-registry



Zpm> Install package



Package zip archive



Zpm requests package and downloads it performs installation in the namespace

ObjectScript Package Manager: How To Use it?

- Installation:
- 1 Install ZPM client from Open Exchange
- Or
- Use the container with ZPM
- Or
- Use template which downloads it

Zpm:USER> search

Zpm:USER> install package-name

NB: You Need InterSystems IRIS for ZPM!

- Everything (almost)!
- ObjectScript classes deployment
- Globals deployment
- CSP applications and security setup
- REST-API applications setup
- Frontend app deployment
- Dependent modules deployment
- What else do you need?)

How to Submit my App as a Package?

1. Add Module.xml in the repo root
2. Submit Application to Github
3. Submit Application to Open Exchange
- ...
4. If Everything is fine your package is published!
5. Can I have my registry? - YES!
